Jim Fritsch made a motion, seconded by Beth Meyers, to approve \$10,000.00 from Belterra Funds to Amack's Well (coffee shop - located in the old Taft Furniture store building), contingent upon them raising \$50,000.00 of the \$60,000.00 needed for construction and startup costs. Before a vote was taken Mr. Fritsch rescinded his motion. Darrick Cox then made a motion, seconded by Beth Meyers, to approve \$10,000.00 from Belterra Funds contingent upon Amack's Well raising \$45,000.00 of the \$60,000.00 needed.
