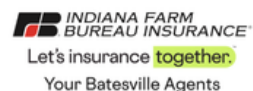

PRE-WEEKEND ACTIVITIES

PATRIOTIC ARTWORK

FRIDAY JULY 3RD

SKATEPARK

Visit the **Batesville Skatepark and Outdoor Adventure** area between 5-7PM during the Fourth of July celebration for the grand opening of the new bouldering wall, featuring climbing routes for all skill levels, climbing challenges with prizes, fun games, and local vendors. Whether you're an experienced climber or trying bouldering for the first time, we'd love to see you there!

DISC GOLF

Try disc golf during the community "Come Give It a Try" event designed for beginners, families, and anyone interested in learning more about the sport.

ACTIVITIES FOR KIDS

The **YMCA Kid Zone** will be set up at the playground of the Bill Gillespie Soccer Park from 5-8 PM. There will be fun, family-friendly activities for all ages, including Firecracker Ring Toss, Knock Down the Fireworks, patriotic coloring, bubbles, chalk, temporary tattoos, and face painting. Kids can earn tickets to redeem for prizes while enjoying an evening full of patriotic fun and entertainment.

BASEBALL

Celebrate America's pastime by watching the local recreational baseball league's tournament championship games take place throughout the Fourth of July celebration weekend at the plex. The games will start approximately at 5PM.

PATRIOTIC COSTUME CONTEST

Join the Patriotic Costume Contest, hosted by **Mayor John Irrgang and his wife, Janna**, at 7PM on the Main Stage at The Plex. Dress in your best red, white, and blue outfit for a chance to win prizes, ribbons, and a spot on a special float in the Fourth of July parade.

MUSIC

Enjoy live music, sponsored by **Batesville Area Arts Council**, throughout the evening at The Plex, beginning at 4PM, and concluding with Lincoln Street Band performing '80s classic rock at 8pm right before the fireworks celebration. See the full lineup at Batesville4th.com.

FIREWORKS

End the evening with Batesville's Fourth of July fireworks display beginning at approximately 10PM.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Arrive early, bring your patience, and enjoy the celebration! Guests are encouraged to bring a picnic, blankets, coolers, and drinks to enjoy throughout the festivities. Several local restaurants will also offer picnic-style carryout options that you can pick up and bring with you (*visit Batesville4th.com to see who's participating and what they're offering*). Everyone is encouraged to help keep Batesville beautiful by making sure their trash ends up in a trash container at the end of the night (please consider bringing a trash bag from home).

PARKING & SHUTTLES

Parking near The Plex and Liberty Park will fill quickly, especially before the fireworks. Thanks to **Batesville Community School Corporation**, free shuttle service will run between the public parking lot across from Weigel Funeral Home on George Street and The Plex throughout the evening to help guests travel more easily between festivities. Please check the website for more information. Please remember that if you use the BCSC bus, you will have to place your cooler in the underfloor storage area during the ride.

PLEASE LEAVE PETS AT HOME

Large crowds, loud music, and fireworks can be stressful for pets. Event organizers encourage guests to leave pets safely at home during the July 3 festivities.

BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR

Visitors are asked to respect private property, stay on sidewalks, avoid blocking driveways, and help keep Batesville welcoming and community-focused during the busy holiday weekend.

AFTER THE FIREWORKS

Large crowds are expected for fireworks, so guests should plan for extra time when leaving parking lots or waiting for shuttle transportation at the end of the evening.

SATURDAY JULY 4TH

FOUR ON THE FOURTH

Start your Independence Day with Batesville's annual **Four on the Fourth** run/walk, a fundraiser for **Every Sole Counts**. Same-day registration and packet pickup start at 7AM at Liberty Park, or pre-register online. Details at Batesville4th.com

FARMERS MARKET

Shop local at the **Batesville Farmers Market** featuring fresh produce, homemade baked goods, handcrafted items, and more from local vendors and small businesses. Market opens at 8am

PARADE

Celebrate hometown pride at the annual Fourth of July Parade, featuring patriotic floats, community groups, music, classic vehicles, local organizations, and fun for all ages. Pre-registration is only required for floats. The parade will line up at 8:30AM at the corner of Columbus Avenue and Huntersville Road, and start at 10AM. EUREKA BAND

Enjoy a patriotic performance by the **Eureka Band** featuring classic American favorites immediately following the parade. Performance will be at the gazebo in Liberty Park.

COMMUNITY PICNIC

Gather at Liberty Park for the Community Picnic, hosted by the **American Legion and VFW**. They are providing free hot dogs, as well as hamburgers and brats for purchase. Plan to enjoy the festivities at the park until around 12:15-12:30PM, then make the rest of the day your own.

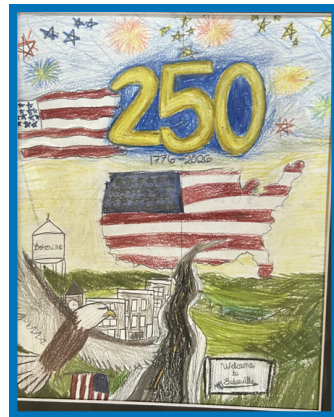

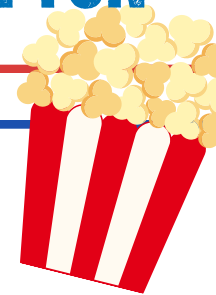

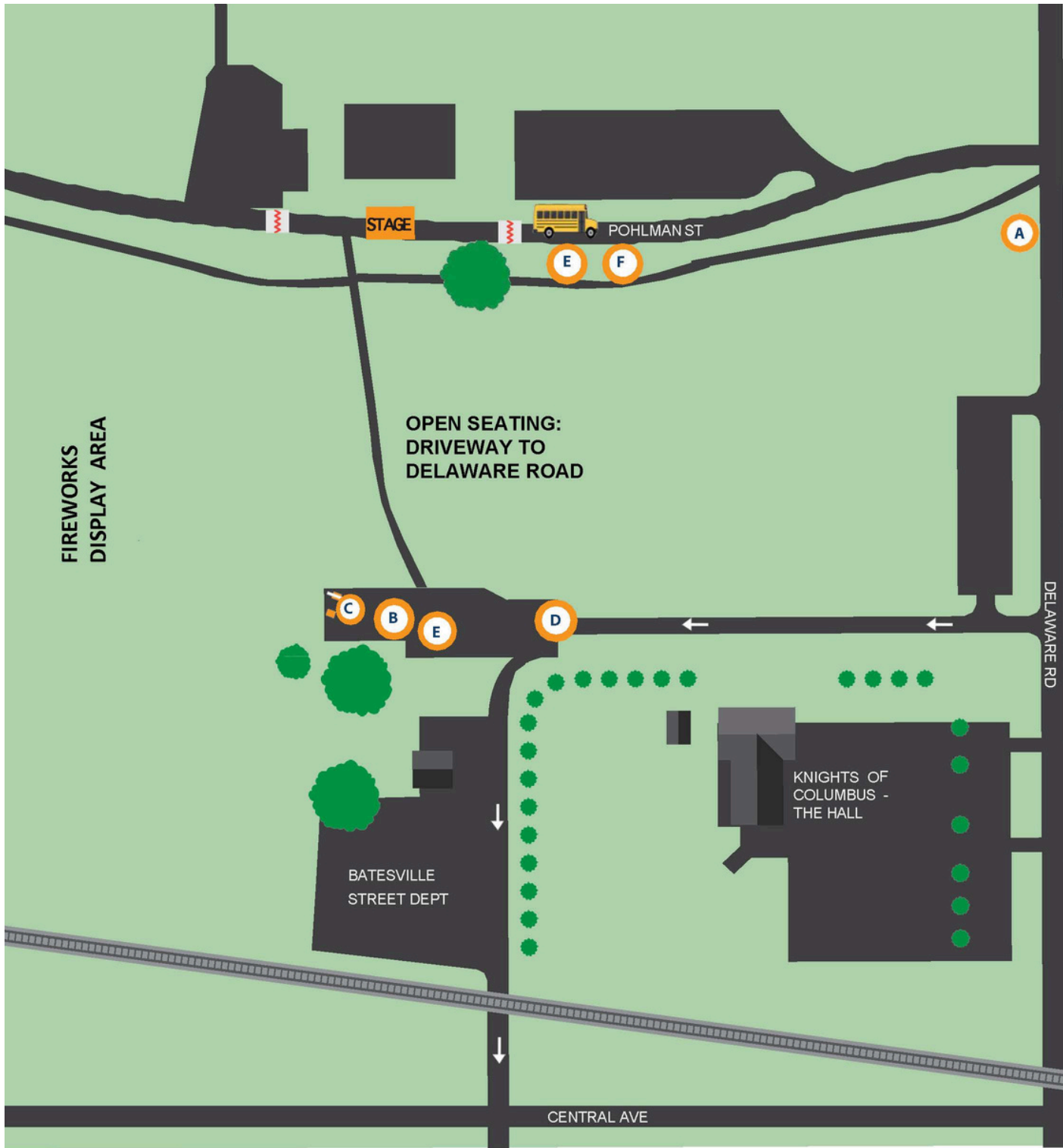

FIREWORK VIEWING AREA

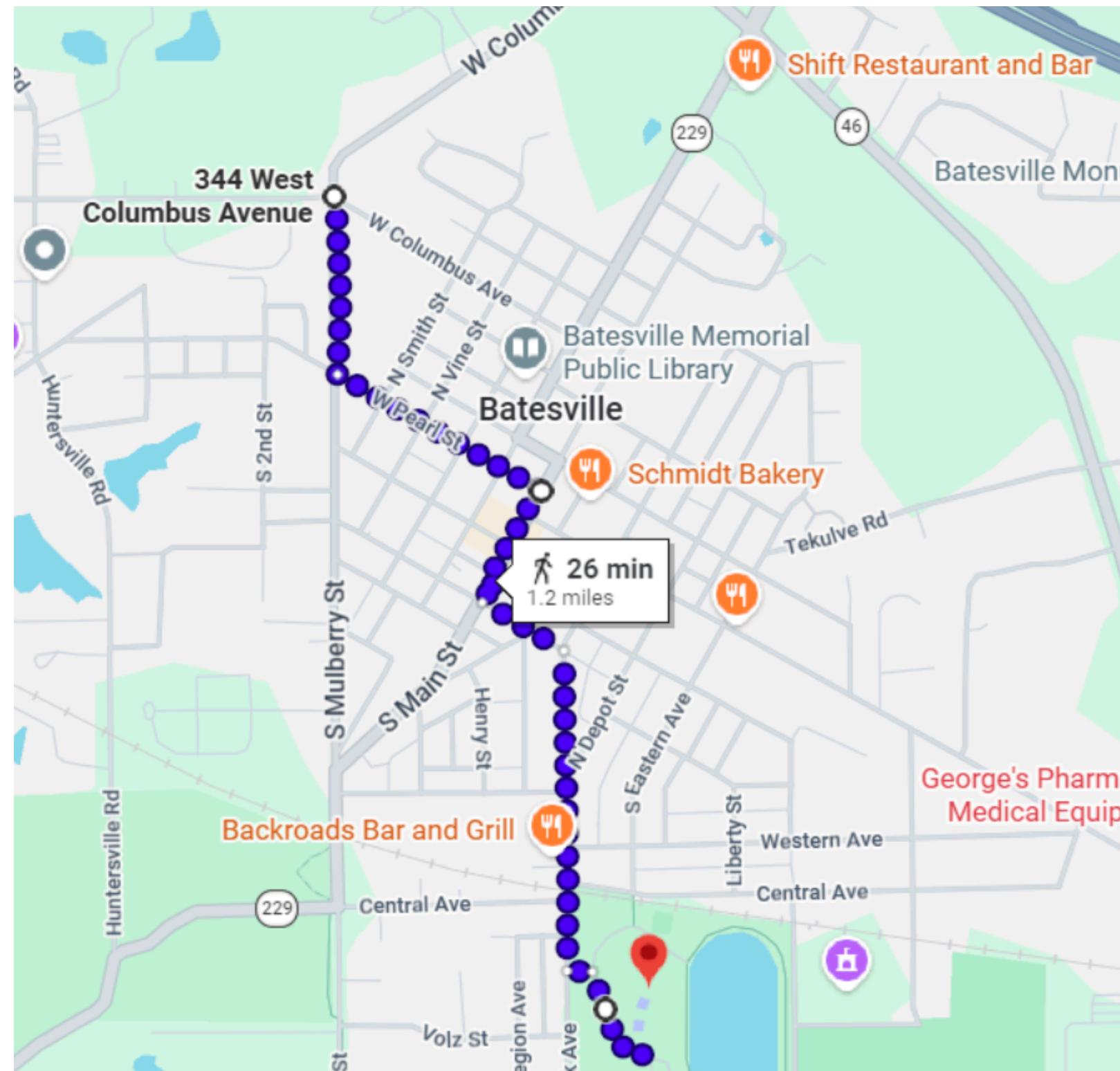


Bill Gillespie Soccer Park
